Micro Purchase Thresholds

- \$10,000 for Supplies
- \$2,500 for Services
- \$2,000 for Construction
- For procurements below the Micro Purchase Threshold, Government Purchase Card holders may use their Government Purchase Card.



For Procurements that exceed the MicroPurchase Threshold

- All Businesses MUST be registered in the System for Award Management (SAM)
- To register in SAM

- There are no exceptions for this requirement

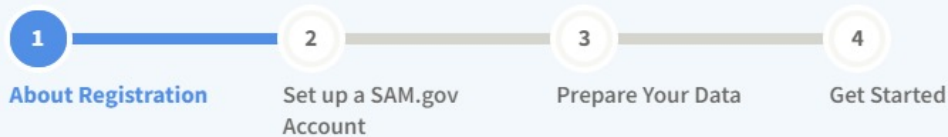
Getting Started with Registration

Get Started with Registration and the Unique Entity ID

Submitting a registration and getting a Unique Entity ID are FREE.

Before You Get Started

Review these steps to choose which option is right for you. You can register to bid and apply for federal awards or you can request a Unique Entity ID only without having to complete a registration.



1 About Registration

If you want to apply for federal awards as a prime awardee, you need a **registration**.

A registration allows you to bid on government contracts and apply for federal assistance. As part of registration, we will assign you a Unique Entity ID.

If you do not want to apply directly for awards, then you do not need a registration. If you only conduct certain types of transactions, such as reporting as a sub-awardee, you may not need to complete a registration. You may only need a **Unique Entity ID**.

Project Examples

MS Military Department (State Contracting)

- Mississippi National Guard State Resources
 - Purchasing and Contracting Division, Curtis Boddy, Director
 - Contacting opportunities from \$75,000 and above for construction, professional services, engineering services, trades services, equipment and commodities based on competitive bidding.
 - Purchasing opportunities from \$5,000.01 to \$75,000 based on competitive quotes from two (2) sources for services, equipment and commodities.
 - Purchasing opportunities less than \$5,000.01 for services, equipment and commodities based on a single quote.
 - Generally, vendors should be registered in the Mississippi MAGIC system and have a State of Mississippi Vendor Number. Construction projects subject to bidding require a Certificate of Responsibility issued by The State Board of Contactors. Additionally, some contacts require the business to be in "Good Standing" with the Mississippi Secretary of State Office.
