- No SB response go to full and open competition
- Quick procurement process (30 days)
- Do not have an acquisition forecast

## What Can Small Businesses Do?

- 1) Register your company at [sam.gov](http://sam.gov).
- 2) Register in the NASA Vendor Database.
- 3) Review the NASA Acquisition Forecast and Active Contract Listings (ACLs) for opportunities.
- 4) Once an opportunity is identified, contact the FOIA Officer or the Small Business Specialist (SBS) at that center to request a copy of the SOW
- 5) Review the SOW to ensure your capabilities match the requirements.
- 6) Determine if you will bid solo or team with the incumbent or other company
- 7) Contact the SBS in regards to the incumbent POC information for an introduction.
- 8) Attend NASA outreach events for network/ matchmaking opportunities with other NASA prime contractors.
